



The concept of attraversiamo has to do with taking a step from going to one safety net to another one. Like that there is a safety boundary and the crossing path is the in between zone between both of those regions. The focus is on the legs only, this as a statement of verticality. The human being different from the apes by standing and walking straight up, a homo erectus. The walking upright is what makes us human and so different from other animals as well. Focusing on those legs accentuate that verticality, reaching for higher feeling. The first steps we make as babies are so important, the parents when seeing those precious moments are absolutely delighted of seeing this and being a part of it experience. We often take for granted that we are able to walk straight and thus this series wants to let the viewer think about this concept.
